Introduction

The Department of Conservation and Climate is seeking a qualified candidate to fill the Environmental Remediation and Contract Manager (EG4) position. Environmental Remediation is a key program area and provides an emphasis on orphaned and abandoned mines and requires geotechnical engineering expertise regarding the stability and integrity for sites that have been identified as an environmental liability.

The Manitoba government has a comprehensive benefits package which includes extended health care, health spending account, dental care, vision care, long term disability insurance, group life insurance, maternity/paternity leave, family related leave, and a defined pension plan (some pension plans allow for portability between the Civil Service Superannuation Board and employers).

Conditions of Employment:

- Must be registered as a Professional Engineer (P.Eng) with Engineers Geoscientists Manitoba. Professional Engineers licensed to practice in other Canadian jurisdictions must be eligible for registration as a Professional Engineer with Engineers Geoscientists Manitoba

- Experience successfully managing complex projects

- Superior written communication skills, including the ability to write sensitive material for senior leaders as well as a variety of authority seeking documents

Duties:

The Environmental Remediation and Contract Manager for this program will be required to provide specialized geotechnical and environmental engineering services and also will be in the position to manage external consultants and contracts. This position will be reviewing, evaluating and making recommendations on the scientific and engineering validity and applicability of externally prepared site assessments, remedial action plans, and the closure reports for which the department is responsible and liable for. This position is also responsible for contract management of the program including preparing the scope of work and deliverables for proposals for remediation and site assessments along with getting appropriate approvals for contracting work within the Manitoba government.
